

2010 OLD VINE MALBEC, STOLEN HORSE VINEYARD

Standing in this vineyard first planted nearly 100 years ago, watching the horses till the soil just as they have for a century, it's easy to understand this Malbec's magnificent terroir expression. Intense, fresh red and black fruits combine with linear minerality, bright acidity and silky tannins to produce a powerful, elegant and sultry seduction in a glass.

Raised entirely in new oak, it has an intense, heady bouquet with blackberry, peppermint, a touch of sous-bois and a slight fug of alcohol. The palate is full-bodied with layers of ripe black, tarry fruit. It is well-balanced and very harmonious. What could be overpowering is extremely refined and well-balanced towards the decadent finish...
